I understand that this is very early in the planning process, so no proposed paths have been outlined. How will you go about finding prefered locations for corridors? I would like to express concern about proposed wilderness areas. A proposed area would be ineligible for wilderness designation if an energy corridor was established on it. Other concerns include habitat fragmentation, erosion, and location of future oil/gas operations based on access to these corridors. Having easy access to these pipelines will encourage mining activites near the corridors, so it is not just about where the pipes will go, but also where future drilling rigs will pop up.

I am mostly curious about the criteria you will use to decide which paths to allocate for

the corridors.
